Bass Tournament Rules

1. Tournament fees are \$70.00 per boat, \$10.00 (optional Big Bass Pot). Entries will still be accepted at the ramp.
2. All participants must be in line to weigh fish by the time designated on the tournament flyer. Failure to do so will lead to disqualification. No EXCEPTIONS!!
3. There is a half (1/2) pound penalty for a dead fish. Only one dead fish may be weighed per boat.
4. Artificial lures only.
5. Each person is responsible for seeing all rules of safety and sportsmanship are followed even if the boat does not belong to them.
6. All Large Mouth and Kentucky Spotted Mouth Bass must be 14 inches long. Small Mouth Bass must measure 18 inches long. All species will be measured on a Golden Rule.
7. Fishing is permitted anywhere within the tournament waters, or connecting waters accessible by boat during specific times except there is no fishing within 50 yards of a gas pump, the weigh-in area 15 minutes before the weigh-in starts and any area designated "no fishing" by the governing body of the lake.
8. Life jackets and Kill Switches must be worn when boat is on plane.
9. Participants must be able to pass random polygraph test.
10. **Any short fish brought to weigh-in will result in immediate disqualification!! NO EXCEPTIONS!!**
11. The Tournament Committee reserves the right to delay blast-off for safety reasons, Fog, Severe Weather, etc.
12. Each team member must have a valid Tennessee fishing license.
13. Any occurrence not covered by the rules will be governed by tournament director Reed Durham.
14. Any breach of the above rules will result in automatic disqualification. All interpretation of the above rules is subject to the Sports Council of Wilson County Bass Fishing Tournament Committee, Tournament Director Reed Durham. All decisions by the Director and Committee are final.
